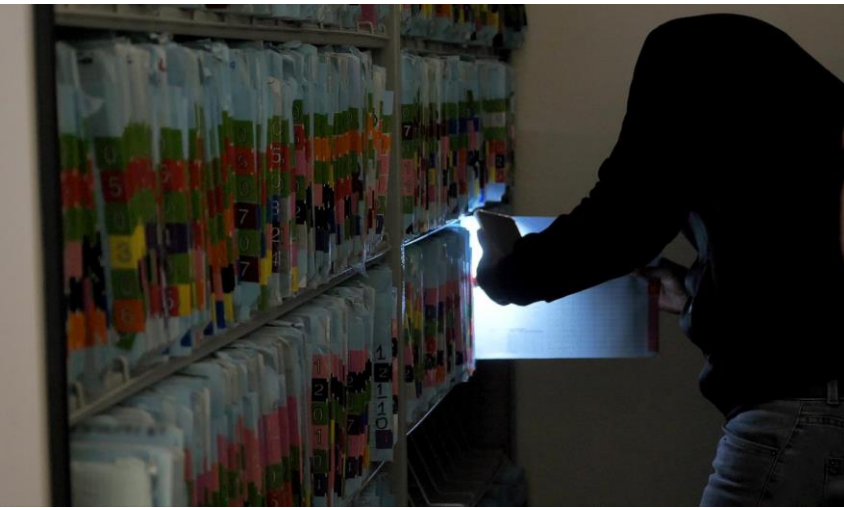

What CLM needs to thrive & survive



1. Different models to reach the communities and understand their needs

2. Automation is essential for programs at scale

3. Funding mechanisms that allow independence and for communities to do proper CLM

4. Partnerships between community led organisations towards consortia to lead national CLM

5. Work with national government to have access to anonymised, aggregate HIV programme data
